What does the CLCA do?

CLCA focuses on and represents the interests of Crystal Lake cottagers.

- We keep the welcome signs and various planters looking beautiful.
- We offer discount cards for use at local businesses for CLCA members.
- We support Crystal Lake events such as the Crystal Lake Triathlon, Rock Bass Derby and the Skating Party on Family Day Weekend.
- We maintain a website and Facebook page to keep cottagers informed.
- We make donations to and support our local volunteer organizations.

CLCA acts as a liaison and represents cottagers on various important matters that arise in the community that may impact cottagers and the Crystal Lake area.

- We liaise with the Municipality of Trent Lakes Council and staff regarding waste management, roadway maintenance, septic inspection program and environmental and development concerns.
- We support the Crystal Lake Steward who takes water samples to be tested by the Ministry of the Environment to monitor the water quality of the lake for clarity, phosphorus levels and invader species (i.e. zebra mussels).

We also maintain membership with various associations to provide a united voice for Crystal Lake on these important matters including:

Galway and Area Ratepayers Association Incorporated (GARAI):

- a community based organization, dedicated to working with area associations, residents, businesses, local township, and various levels of government to find solutions to issues that are common among property owners in our area.
- A strong and active Environment Committee who coordinate the Turtle Crossing & Adopt-A-Road Programs.

✓ Federation of Ontario Cottagers' Associations (FOCA):

- a non-profit, voluntary organization that represents over 500 Ontario cottage associations at the provincial level, dedicated to supporting the interests of Ontario's waterfront property owners.
- FOCA is an active supporter of:
 - Waterfront Ratepayers After Fair Taxation (WRAFT) which is a coalition of waterfront associations across Ontario working to achieve equity in waterfront property taxation; and
 - Coalition After Property Tax Reform (CAPTR) which is an alliance of over 700 ratepayer organizations striving to bring equity and stability to residential property tax system.

Coalition for Equitable Water Flow (CEWF):

- Work to implement equitable water management policy for the Trent-Severn Waterway taking all those affected into account.

Land Transfer Station and Waste Management

The Township has a Waste Management Advisory Committee that has three resident representatives including one from Crystal Lake. We continue to advocate for the Crystal Lake cottagers and area residents.

A concern of the Township continues to be that garbage found in the bags going into the bins could have been recycled or redirected from the garbage. Top offenders include liquor bottles, meta



garbage. Top offenders include liquor bottles, metal cans, plastic containers as well as kitchen organics, electronics and hazardous waste.

The reality is that it is very costly to transport garbage that goes into the bins, and whatever can be diverted to the recycle bins helps to decrease these costs.

You can now take your brush to the Crystal Lake Transfer site. We are still working hard to also get a mobile hazardous waste pick-up and organics brought to the Crystal Lake transfer station.

However, in the meantime we are asking all of you to PLEASE do your part to recycle. We will be providing education, training and promotion on what and how to recycle.

Septic Tank Inspection Program

The Municipality of Trent Lakes has contracted the Peterborough County-City Health Unit (PCCHU) to conduct inspections of septic tanks throughout the entire municipality starting this year.

The intent of this program is to protect our surface water and groundwater quality from being affected by poorly functioning septic systems.

Inspections will be conducted on sewage systems installed more than 5 years ago. The cycle of inspections will span several years with a different area of the municipality being inspected each year. Property owners will be notified by mail when their system is due for inspection.

We do not expect Crystal Lake to be a part of the inspection area for this year.
